COVID-19 and hearing loss

A recent study looked at whether infection with the novel coronavirus was associated with hearing loss.

Researchers chose test subjects who were positive for the new coronavirus but did not have symptoms. The test subjects were between 20 and 50 years old, with no history of hearing loss or known causes of hearing loss (noise, family history).

Test results showed that although the subjects still had “normal” hearing, there were significant changes in the high frequency area, both in how softly they could hear the tones and in how healthy their inner ears were. More


